We will be writing a biography about a significant historical figure.</p> <p><b>Activities</b>  <b>Monday – We are completing our VIPERS lesson</b></p> <p>Our VIPERS lesson is based on the text "Biography of Charles Darwin" read through the text on the document labelled "<i>Monday - English - Vipers – Biography of Charles Darwin</i>" and answer the questions on the document labelled "<i>Monday - English - Vipers – Biography of Charles Darwin Questions</i>"</p> <p><b>Tuesday – We are planning part of our biography on Anne Frank using our research notes.</b></p> <p>The children will plan the historical events which led to Anne Frank hiding away. Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2021 is 'World Book Day'.

'World Book Day' is a fantastic opportunity for you to celebrate your love of reading.

However, we would like you to be as creative as you can! Think about what items you have around your home that could help you create your favourite character. Mr Lord would also like it if you could record yourself reading a chapter of your favourite book so why not make yourself comfortable and enjoy a good book!
