

Year Two Maths Reasoning Paper

The first five questions in this paper are read out to the children by their class teacher. Below are the questions for this paper.

Question 1	<p>What Is twenty <u>add</u> two <u>add</u> two?</p> <p>Write your answer in the box.</p>
Question 2	<p>I am thinking of a number.</p> <p>It has <u>four</u> tens and <u>two</u> ones.</p> <p>Write my number in the box.</p>
Question 3	<p>Look at the circle.</p> <p>Part of the circle is shaded.</p> <p>Tick the fraction below that shows the <u>shaded</u> part of the circle.</p> <p>Put your tick in the box by the correct fraction.</p>
Question 4	<p>Turn the page over and look at question 4.</p> <p>There are <u>thirteen</u> marbles in a jar.</p> <p>The jar can hold <u>twenty</u> marbles.</p> <p>How many more marbles can fit in the jar?</p> <p>Write your answer in the box.</p>
Question 5	<p>Write the <u>same</u> number in both boxes to make the multiplication correct.</p>
