Background Information

The children will have completed activities in pre-school/Nursery relating to themselves and their families.

They may be aware of some parts of their bodies and which parts are linked to the senses.

The children may be aware that we live and go to school in Long Sutton.

Interesting facts

- Each person is different in lots of ways. They can have different hair, colour, skin, colour, be tall or short, live in different countries as well as many other things. No two people are the same.
- Our bodies have lots of different parts that help it to move. We have a skeleton made up of bones which are covered in skin. We also have muscles attached to our bones that help us to move.
- A human body has a face. Most people usually have 2 eyes, a nose and a mouth on their face with ears on the side of their head. These parts of our face help us to see, hear and smell as well as helping us to show how we are feeling.
- Humans live on planet Earth. Our planet is very important and there are lots of things that we can do to look after it such as recycling as well as being kind and friendly to make it a nice place for everyone to live in.
- Our family is the group of important people who we can call by special names such as aunty, Grandpa, cousin etc Some of our family live in the same house as us but some may not.
- Our school is in the town of Long Sutton but people who come to our school can live nearby in places such as Gedney, Sutton Bridge or other towns and villages near us.
- Humans change as they grow and get taller and older. This can sometimes change the way they look too.

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| Face | The part of our body with our eyes, nose and mouth . |
| Body | The physical whole of a person. |
| Human | A man, woman, child or person. |
| Family | The people who live with us or who we can call by special names such as Mummy, Daddy, Nanny, Uncle etc |
| Earth | The planet which humans live on. |
| Home | Another word for a house which is the place you live. |
| Town | A group of houses which are near each other where people live. There may also be shops, doctors and other buildings. |
| Autumn | A time of year when leaves fall of the tree and the weather changes to become cooler and sometimes windy. |
