Term 4



Maths

This term we will be finishing our look at fractions : equivalence; improper fractions; and the addition and subtraction of fractions.. We are also studying decimals and we will revisit measure.

We will continue to focus on the children's recall of their multiplication tables.

Science

Children learn that sounds are caused by vibrations. They learn that sounds travel from an object, through a medium (usually the air), travel into the ear where they are carried down the ear canal and processed by the brain.
