

PSHE (Jigsaw)

In our PSHE lessons this term, we will be completing the unit entitled, 'Changing Me!'. 

RE

In our RE lessons this term, the children will be exploring Life Journeys. 

PE

In their PE lessons this term, the children will be doing Tag Rugby (Tuesday) and Netball (Friday). 

Art/DT

In their Art and DT lessons this term, the children will be making props for their end of year production using a range of Art and DT skills. 


Maths

The children will begin the term by continuing their learning on 'Angles'. We will begin by exploring the sum of angles on a straight line, within a triangle and then exploring how we can use a formula to calculate the sum of angles within regular polygons. As always, the children will be encouraged to apply their knowledge of different angle types and sums to solve increasingly complex problems which will require them to reason mathematically.

Following this, the children will once again by exploring the properties of both 2D and 3D shapes before exploring the nets of 3D shapes in more detail.

We will conclude the year by completing mini projects that will require the children to draw on a range of mathematical knowledge and skills from across Key Stage 2.

English

The children will begin their English lessons this term by writing a non-chronological report. Within this particular unit of work, the children will be encouraged to use topic specific vocabulary and a range of structural and organisational devices e.g. bullet points and sub-headings to organise their research and writing. 

Following this, the children will have a week of 'Free Writing' where they will be able to choose a genre of writing that interests them.

Music

In their Music lessons this term, the children will be learning the songs for their end of year production.

Science

This term in Science, the children will be learning about the importance of diet and exercise on the human body. 

As a class, we will research and discuss the importance of exercise to humans and will begin to explore the effect of drugs and smoking on the human body.

Topic

Our Topic lessons this term will focus on 'Transition'. Throughout the course of the term, we will work with the children to ensure that they feel comfortable with their transition to secondary school and are able to express any concerns and/or worries they might have. As always, we will ensure that we listen to their worries and provide them with appropriate strategies and as many helpful hints and tips as we can to ensure that we send them on their way prepared!

Topic related vocabulary: transition, change, worries/concerns, emotion vocabulary e.g. happy, sad, anxious etc. familiar, unfamiliar.
