Maths – area, perimeter, length, denominator, numerator, equal parts, improper fraction

English – inverted commas, speech marks, comma, rhyme, rhythm, poem, verse, Shakespeare,

Year 3 – Term 4 Behind the Scenes

Computing

Children will be learning to use branching databases through Purple Mash.

English

We will be writing a narrative stories with dialogue that includes inverted commas (speech marks). This writing will be based on some of Shakespeare's plays. As part of this, and our production, we will learn about how plays are performed and the importance of stage directions when performing a play

We will also be learning about performance poetry.

We will continue to focus on using different sentence structures. We will also be learning different spelling rules each week.

Maths

We will be learning to calculate with money. We will learn how to calculate area and perimeter and begin working with fractions.

Every week they will complete an arithmetic test and practice times table.

PSHE

Our topic for this term is 'Healthy Me. The children will talk about how to stay healthy physically and mentally. This will focus on healthy eating and the importance of exercise.

Science

The theme for this term is Light. Children will learn that light comes from a source and about how shadows are created.

ART/DT

This term the children will be learning about the history behind Pop Art and about some of the famous Pop artists. They will recreate their own versions of some famous Pop art

FRENCH

This term children will continue learning how to greet one another, to introduce themselves and to count to 20. They will also learn some vocabulary around Easter and pancake day.

RE

In term 4, children will be continuing to learn about the different incarnations of God in the Trinity – the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. They will learn about how these aspects are represented in art and the Bible.
