

Vocabulary

Maths - one, more, less, ten, sorting, groups, order, bigger, smaller, size, shape and colour.

English - full stops, capital letters, finger spaces.

Science - deciduous and ever green trees, legs, arms, head, feet, toes, hands, ears, smell, taste, hear, touch and see.

History - Past, Present, Future.

Geography - Shop, town, village,

British Value - Democracy and voting.

ART/DT

In Art, the children will be mixing colours and using a range of marks and materials to produce a self-portrait.

Language of the term

Our language of the term is Spanish and we will also look at the artist Picasso.

Our children will continue to learn Makaton throughout the year.

RE

In R.E. the children will be learning about places of worship focussing on Christianity. We hope to make a visit to Long Sutton church later in the term.

English

In English this term we will start the year off by looking at 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers.

After this topic, much of the children's learning will revolve around the story of "The Gruffalo". The children will be learning about labels, lists and captions, exploring stories with familiar settings and writing a recount. We will also be continuing our daily Phonics lessons.

Year 1 - Term 1 All About Me.

Science

In science, the children will be identifying parts of the human body and exploring their five senses through an investigation. We will also begin our learning of the four seasons with particular emphasis on the seasonal change from summer to autumn.

Maths

In maths children will be learning how to group objects based on a characteristic, counting objects correctly, representing numbers using equipment, counting one more and one less, using the more than and less than sign and beginning to count backwards.

PE

PE lessons will be delivered during Y1 PPA. Please ensure children come in to school in their PE kits on a Tuesday and Wednesday.

Music

In music children will be learning about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.

PSHE

The 'Jigsaw' lessons will focus on "Being Me in My World" which will enable the children to settle into their new surroundings in Year 1.

Geography / History

In History children will be exploring what has happened during their life and how their needs have changed and what they have learnt to do since birth. In Geography children will be learning how to find their way around school and all about their local area identify specific features.
