

Vocabulary

Maths - number bonds, addition, subtraction, less, more.

English - full stops, capital letters, finger spaces, adjectives.

Science - rough, smooth, hard, soft, length, day, shorter, longer.

Art - Vincent Van Gogh, watercolours, silhouette

History - Guy Fawkes, Gun Powder Plot, London, Houses of Parliament, Dick Turpin Way, Swapcoat Lane, Highway Man

ART/DT

In Art, the children will be creating their own versions of Van Gogh's "Starry night" using a range of techniques.

Computing

Children will learn about online safety this term.

RE

In R.E. the children will continue learning about Christianity with a focus on the creation story and the beliefs of Christians relating to this.

English

In English this term we will be using Paddington to explore how to write simple sentences, use the conjunction and, using adjectives to describe and using full stops, capital letters and full stops.

Science

Maths

In maths this term, we will be learning to use the part, whole model, find and compare number bonds to and within 10, addition involving the introduction of the symbol, adding together, adding more and finding a part, subtraction involving the introduction of the symbol, finding a part and breaking apart, fact families and counting back and 2D and 3D shapes.
