Focus country for the year
Brazil

RE

In RE we will be learning in more depth about Christmas and why it's so important to Christians. The children will know that Jesus is the son of God.

English

We will be reading *The Great Kapok Tree* by Lynne Cherry, and using this to learn more about the Amazon Rainforest. We will make links to our work on Brazil, and our Science work on habitats. The children will continue to receive daily teaching of spelling, as well as weekly grammar lessons. Please support your child by reading with them at home regularly.

Year 2 - Term 6 Carnival Time!

Science

The children will be learning about plants. They will plant different seeds and bulbs and observe how they change and grow over the term. They will investigate what plants need to grow and stay healthy. They will also observe how animals grow and have offspring.

Maths

We will be learning about time- this will include being able to tell the time to the hour, half hour, quarter hour and eventually to 5 minute intervals. Then the children will look at duration of time and comparing units of time.

Later on in the term we will continue to look at measurements, linked to capacity and mass. We will explore units of measurement and appropriate equipment as well as solve problems involving capacity and mass.

PE

The children will continue following 'Get Set 4 PE' Striking and Fielding on Wednesdays, and Invasion Games on Thursdays. Children should come to school dressed in their kit.

Music

The children will complete the unit 'Round and Round', learning how to sing songs in a round.

PSHE

The children will follow the Jigsaw unit Changing Me.

Geography

We will begin by comparing England and Brazil in terms of size, population etc. We will locate them on a world map and apply knowledge of continents to describe where they are. We will then compare Lincolnshire with Rio de Janeiro, looking at landmarks and landscape.
