

Vocabulary

Maths – place value, tens, ones, rotate, clockwise, anti-clockwise, half past, o'clock, pence, pounds
English – full stop, capital letter, finger space, question mark, punctuation, conjunction, patterned language, heading, sub-heading, facts, fiction, non-fiction, photograph.
Science - amphibians, reptiles, mammals, carnivore, omnivore, herbivore, fish, fur, habitat, tail, scales,
Art – primary colours, secondary colours, colour wheel, tones, inks, dyes, mixing, media, technique
Geography – United Kingdom, capital city, seas, surrounding, Scotland, England, Wales, Northern Ireland, Wales

ART/DT

In Art the children will be studying paintings by Vincent Scarpase. We will be identifying primary and secondary colours and experimenting with different media.

RE

The children will be learning about different places of worship.

Maths

This term in Maths in Geometry, we will be exploring position and direction. We will then move onto Place Value within 100 where we will count forwards and backwards to 200, partitioning, comparing and ordering number within 100. In addition to this, the children will be sequencing events, telling the time to the hour and half an hour.

We will also explore money; recognising coins and notes as well as counting in coins.

English

We will explore patterned language through the story 'Tiddler' by Julia Donaldson. This will allow children to discuss how language pattern has an effect on the reader.

We will then be exploring Information Texts focusing on sea creatures. The children will use a variety of resources to conduct their factual research.

Moving forward, the children will learn to identify and name a variety of common animals, as well as this, they further compare the structure of different animals.
