## RE

In RE we will be learning in more depth about Christmas and why it's so important to Christians. The children will know that Jesus is the son of God.

## English

To begin the term, we will explore some books by the children's author Emily Gravett. We will then be reading The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry, and using this to learn more about the Amazon Rainforest.

We will make links to our work on Brazil, and our Science work on habitats. The children will continue to receive daily teaching of spelling, as well as weekly grammar lessons.

## Year 2 – Term 6 Carnival Time!

## Science

The children will be learning about plants. They will plant different seeds and bulbs and observe how they change and grow over the term. They will investigate what plants need to grow and stay healthy. They will also observe how animals grow and have offspring.

## Maths

We will begin the term by learning about 'Position and Direction'. Children will learn to describe position and direction using a range of mathematical vocabulary before creating their own instructions. We will then move onto our final topic of 'Mass, Capacity and Temperature' where children will explore the things used to measure these and use appropriate standard units to accurately measure them. They will then solve problems involving measurement.

## PE

The children will continue following 'Get Set 4 PE' Striking and Fielding on Wednesdays, and Team Building on Thursdays. Children should come to school dressed in their kit.

## Music

The children will learn about how music can play a part in their daily life and improve the quality of their life.

## PSHE

This term we will be learning about Brazil and comparing it to England. The children will start by focusing on what it is like to live in Lincolnshire and then comparing our life to the lives of people in Rio de Janeiro. We will end our topic in the final week of term with a carnival!
