

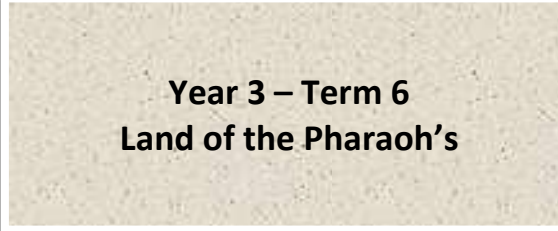
Vocabulary

Year 3 – Term 6 Land of the Pharaoh's

Computing

This term we are learning all about emails. We will be learning how to write and send an email, as well as then learning how to open and read emails.

History

This term in History we will be learning about life in Ancient Egypt, including their burial practices such as making mummies and building pyramids. We will also learn about the impact of the Ancient Egyptian civilisation on other countries around the world.

English

This term in English we will be focusing on Traditional Tales. We will be looking at the features and what is needed to make a traditional tale. We will be taking parts from different traditional tales to make our own. We will also be looking at information texts, and again what the features are. We will be linking our information texts to our work on Ancient Egypt. The SPaG element of this term will heavily focus on punctuation and using more adventurous language.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be finishing our work on time. We will recapping on how to tell the time, including to the minute. Also, the children will be using the 24-hour clock and solving problems involving time. We will then be moving on to the properties of shape where they will work with angles, and being able to draw accurately before moving on to recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes. Then finishing the year on mass and capacity.

Every week we will complete an arithmetic test and practice times table.

PSHE

This term in PSHE our topic is 'Changing Me' we look at how we have changed since birth, and how babies grow. We then discuss any changes that may happen to us that we can see on the outside and then on the inside. Then as we are nearing the end of the school year we talk about changes in terms of going up to Year 4.

PE

This term our sports are cricket and rounders, we will be practicing ball skills such as throwing, catching and bowling. Before moving on to other skills such as fielding and batting

Science

The theme for this term is Light. They will learn that light comes from a source and about how shadows are created.

DT

In DT this term we will be learning about why levers are used and we will create our own. We will also be applying what we learn about the mummification process to create our own 'mummies'.

French

This term in French we will be continuing to work on everything that we have already learnt this year. Our new content will be months of the year.
