<u>Vocabulary</u> - please help your child learn to spell and understand these words.

<u>Maths</u> – percentages, decimals, thousandths, ordering, comparing, equivalences, 3D shapes, properties, faces, edges, vertices, angles, acute, right angle, obtuse, reflex, protractor.

<u>English</u> – relative clause, relative pronouns, cohesion, parenthesis, balanced arguments, persuasion.

Science and History – see Knowledge Organiser

Environmental Explorers

Summer Term 2 - Year 5

Geography

Children will be learning the course of a river, including learning about the River Nene from source to mouth. We will explore erosion and deposition along the river course practically and learn about dams. Atlas skills will be used to locate world rivers.



Computing

Our unit this topic is 3D modelling. We will be following a brief to design2D nets before going onto creating 3D models from these.

Science

This term our unit is 'Animals including Humans'. We will be exploring changes to the human body from birth to old age, investigating the relationship between growth and development and understanding the changes that happen during puberty.

PSHE - Jigsaw

Children will complete our unit on 'Changing Me' including understanding self body image, how our bodies change through puberty and conception. We will then look ahead to our futures and the transition into Year 6.

Physical Education

PE lessons will be delivered on a Tuesday and Friday afternoon. We will be learning Golf skills on a Tuesday with Mr Nyang and Rounders skills on a Friday with your class teacher.

Please ensure children are wearing appropriate PE kit for being outside on both of these days.

Maths

We will be learning about decimals and percentages before exploring the properties of 3D shapes and developing our knowledge of angles, including use of a protractor to measure and draw angles accurately.

English

We will be exploring how to write a balanced argument focusing on deforestation basing out learning around the book 'There's a Rang-tan in My Bedroom'. We will use all of the persuasive techniques learnt to develop our learning by writing a persuasive letter to our MP on plastic pollution, especially in oceans.

Languages

The children will continue to gain confidence in speaking French. We will have another Microsoft Teams call with our partner school in France.

DT

We will be focusing on cooking this term. We will be exploring the Eatwell plate, begin to understand key terminology such as taste, texture, aroma, appearance and seasonality before making our own pizzas and evaluate them.

Religious Education

The children will be looking at 'Expressing Beliefs through the arts'.
