

# Year 6 Summer Term 2

## Tomorrow's World

### Geography/History:

This term, our Geography and History lessons will be based around our topic of 'Tomorrow's World' where we will be exploring **the future of planet Earth and those who live on it**. We will begin the term by exploring what is meant by the term, 'Fair Trade' and following this, 'sustainability' before progressing to explore how the **actions and decisions** that we, as a race, make currently will impact on the world of tomorrow. We will conclude the term by exploring 'careers' and 'aspirations' and the children will explore their personal **aspirations for the future**.



### Science:

Our Science topic this term is entitled, 'Evolution and Inheritance'. Throughout the course of this term, the children be exploring how animals and humans have evolved over time and any adaptations that have taken place in order to enable them to survive in their habitats. We will also be exploring what is meant by the terms 'inheritance' and 'variation' and investigating the variations that occur between humans and animals.



### Jigsaw:

Our Jigsaw unit this term is entitled, 'Changing Me!':



### English:

In our English lessons this term, the children will be **up-levelling** previously written pieces of work. We will begin the term by **editing and improving** our 'letters from the trenches' ensuring that the children are choosing and using **higher level vocabulary with precision**, considering the **impact on the reader** and also encouraging them to include a range of **higher-level punctuation e.g. semi-colons, colons and dashes**.



Following this, the children will then begin **conducting research** to undertake a debate based on our 'Geography' topic - 'Tomorrow's World'. The children will be **re-searching arguments 'for' and 'against' an issue** before learning how to use these to **construct a viewpoint** in a debate.

### Maths:

This term, in our Maths lessons, the children will be completing a number of projects that will encourage them to draw upon the skills and Knowledge that they have been taught in their Maths lessons this year.

### Music:

In their Music lessons this term, Year 6 will be **learning the songs for their end of year production**, 'Edith's Wartime Scrapbook'.

### RE:

In their RE lessons this term, the children will be learning about 'Life Journeys'.



### PE:

In their PE lessons this term, the children will be developing their **Tennis** skills (Monday) and **Cricket** skills (Tuesday).
