### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will continue to talk about how we are feeling each day.

We will continue to listen to our friends when playing and happily talk to them about our game or things that have been happening at home.

We will be continuing to practice taking turns and sharing the resources.

### Physical development

We will continue to access the outside area where we will be developing our gross motor skills. We will be using the bikes, trikes, throwing and catching balls, and moving in a range of ways. We will also be visiting the wooded area weekly developing our awareness of what is around us. We will develop our fine motor skills by threading beads etc and using the tweezers, pencils and crayons.

### Literacy

We will be continuing encouraging the children to tell us what has happened in the story, telling us the main characters, and who was doing what in the story. We will be encouraging them to think about what might happen next in new stories. We will be encouraging mark making and what these marks mean.

### Maths

We will be continuing to practice our counting daily when we look at how many children are in nursery. We will be learning that numerals match a quantity while having fun playing with Easter eggs. We will be practicing singing a range of number songs.
