The Viking Invaders

Physical Education

This term our focus in PE will be continuing with Gymnastics and Basketball, along with Swimming, Hockey and Athletics.

Maths

We will be learning how to use the method for short division. Then, we will focus on fractions including equivalence, addition, subtraction, multiplication and finding fraction of amounts. In addition, we will begin to learn about decimals.

English

Children will be writing their own myth inspired by main events in our shared text, Beowulf, with a focus on extending their understanding of aspects of Year 5 grammar and sentence structures.

Languages

The children will continue to gain confidence in speaking French. We are hoping to arrange another Skype call with our partner French school.

Art

Art is drawing unit focusing on realism and stylised work. We will explore work by Julian Opie and Colin Davidson, building towards drawing a Viking-style self portrait

Science This term we will be investigating reversible and irreversible changes through a variety of experiments.

PSHE - Jigsaw

Children will learn about the risks associated with smoking and misuse of alcohol. Healthy lifestyles will be explored including the media's portrayal of body image.

Religious Education

The children will continue to learn about aspects of Christianity focussing the theme of incarnation and discussing - 'Was Jesus the Messiah?'

History

Children will further explore the concept of invaders and settlers: exploring when and why the Vikings invaded Britain; beginning to understand why there was a struggle of power between the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings; and finding out about Alfred the Great.

Computing

Children will learn about databases, exploring preprepared ones before creating entries for their own class database. They will also complete a paper worksheet activity learning the difference between the Internet and the World Wide Web.
