

Vocabulary

Maths – compare, tens, ones, long and longer, short, shorter and shortest, heavy, heavier and heaviest, light, lighter and lightest, more than, less than, volume, full, empty, weight, balance.

English – full stop, capital letter, finger space, adjective, punctuation, conjunction, beginning, middle, end.

Science – ash, bark, berry, blossom, deciduous, evergreen, flower, flowering plants, dandelion, stem, trunk.

Art – texture, smooth, rough, bumpy, vibrant, bright, printing, textiles.

Geography – physical features, human features, beach, cliff, town, sea, river, season, near and far, left and right, forest, hill, village, house, shop.

ART

In Art the children will be learning about printing. They will study and explore the work of Henri Rousseau.

RE

We will be continuing our learning about Islam.

Computing

This term, the children will be learning about coding using the Purple Mash software '2Code'. To master coding skills, pupils need to have the opportunity to explore program design and put computational thinking into practice.

English

We will be continuing our daily Phonics lessons.

In English, the children will be studying the Traditional Tale 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. They will use this story as a basis to write their own version. Towards the end of term, the children will be learning to write instructions. Children will explore the key features of an instructional text and use this knowledge to write their own instructions.

Year 1 - Term 4

Gardener's World

Science

In science this term we will be continuing our observation about seasonal change which will be recorded in our class weather diary. Alongside this, the children will be studying about common wild and garden plants. They will be investigated and describing the structure of a plant.

Maths

In Maths the children will be ordering numbers within 50. We will then move on to Measurement where the children will learn about Length and Height. The children will use specific language to show their understanding such as short, shorter, tall and taller when describing and comparing. After this, they will explore Weight and Volume.

PE

PE lessons will be delivered on Monday afternoons and during Y1 PPA on a Tuesday afternoon. Please ensure children are wearing appropriate PE kit for being outside on either of these days.

PSHE

This term's Jigsaw is 'healthy me'. They will explore how to be healthy, making healthy choices and different ways to keep safe e.g. road safety.

Geography

In geography, we will be exploring directional language and how we can apply this to our immediate surroundings. We will then study about human and physical features within different areas, using geographical vocabulary.
