Go on a scavenger hunt- find as many things as you can beginning with the same letter	
Make a paper boat and have a race, how can you make it go faster?	
Make a sock puppet- make up a story about your character	
Blow Bubbles- make some bubble mixture and some bubble wands.	
Who can blow the biggest bubble?	
Bake some biscuits or a cake with an adult	
Make a paper aeroplane- how far will it fly?
