Lay in the garden or at the park and look for shapes in the clouds.

Make and send a card to someone you haven't seen for a while.	
Build a fort using blankets and pillows.	
Pack a picnic and go to the park or the local woods.	
Have a puzzle race – use 100 piece puzzles and see who finishes first.	
Press summer flowers to make a summer picture.	
Have a water fight with your family.	
Play outside in the rain – splash in the puddles, make mud pies.	
Build an obstacle course in the garden.	
Host an outdoor movie night with blankets and popcorn.	
Stargaze – can you work together to find the different star constellations?	
Write a letter to your new teacher.	
Toast marshmallows.	
Create a puppet show.	
Play hopscotch with your family.	
Fly a kite.	
Make a daisy chain.	
Go bird watching, identify and make a tally of the birds in your garden.	
Make a paper boat and have a race, how can you make it go faster?	
Help in the kitchen – chop the vegetables.	
Make a pompom and turn it into an animal.	
Make a summer scrapbook.	
Use an old paintbrush and water to draw on your patio or path. Watch the drawings disappear as they dry!
