<p>The focus for Reception this week is:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Numbers up to 50</b></p> <p><b>This week we are setting a challenge to begin to understand the numbers to 50.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can you write in the missing numbers up to 20 on the number tracks?</li> <li>• Can you cut out the numbers up to 20 and match to the correct tens and ones?</li> <li>• Can you write in the missing numbers up to 50? Ask your adult to help you write the numbers correctly.</li> <li>• Can you cut out the magic beans and stick them in order from 1 to 50?</li> <li>• Can you circle the correct number on the tens frame sheet? Gather sticks and flowers and stick them on to a strip of card and make it into a headband to wear.</p> <p>Cut and stick the animals into their correct habitat.
