School Disco

Dear Parent/Carer,

Friends of Long Sutton Primary School are delighted to be able to have organised a school disco to be held on Friday 11th February. As before, the disco will be split into 2 time slots:

EYFS and KS1 (reception, year 1 and year 2)	5.00-6.30
KS2 (years 3,4,5 and 6)	6.45-8.30

With safety a priority, we have had to make some changes to the way in which we usually run the discos and will be trialling a cashless and paperless system. The disco will appear on parentpay from Tuesday 1st February, and instead of your child bringing a ticket home, their name will be on a list at the entrance. If you wish your child to attend the disco please pay via ParentPay by Friday 4th February to allow time for catering to be arrranged. If you are not in a financial position for your child to attend the disco but they wish to do so, then please speak to a member of the school office team in confidence as they will be able to help.

The price will be £3.50 per child which will include a drink (fruit shoot for EYFS & KS1 and choice of fruit shoot or a can of drink for KS2), one item of hot food (hot dog or pizza slice) and a mixed bag of sweets. If your child has any allergies or dietary requirements please advise us by emailing <u>friends@longsutton.lincs.sch.uk</u>. Please note that on this occasion there will be no option to buy additional food or sweets. If your child requires any extra drink, then this will be free of charge in the form of water or squash.

Please can we remind you that parents are unable to attend the discos with their children, but we will as always need a limited number of parent helpers, and many members of school staff will also be present. If you are able to volunteer as a helper at either disco then please email <u>friends@longsutton.lincs.sch.uk</u>.

Nearer the time and once we have exact numbers, we will be contacting you again with details of disco drop off and collection points for each year group within the school grounds for the evening of 11th February.
