### **Year 4 Kingfisher Class Lincolnshire Energy Trip**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Don't forget it is our visit to 'Lincolnshire Energy from Waste' next week on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April. The aim of the visit is to explore how the waste created in Lincolnshire is converted into electricity, which links with our unit of work on 'Sustainability'.

#### **Waste-free lunch challenge**

To promote the reduction of waste, 'LEfW' has challenged our class to bring their packed lunches using reusable containers and with minimal packaging. Each school's waste will be sorted, weighed and entered into the Waste Free Lunch Challenge.

Ideas - Leftovers, cheese cut from a large block instead of individually wrapped, crisps taken from a large family bag, instead of individual packs, beeswax wraps, or no wrap instead of cling film or foil.

We usually ask children to bring a 'throw-away' lunch, however, to take part in the 'waste-free lunch challenge,' if pupils want to bring their lunchbox and usual drink bottle, then there is a trolley that we can use in the room to store these on (however there is no room for large school bags). If you have already ordered a school meal for this day, a pack up will be substituted. Please do not send children with sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks.

Just to remind you - the **coach will leave school at 8.30am and will return at approximately 4pm** – **please note that this is a change from the original time of 3.30pm. Children will therefore need to arrive at school at 8.15am** so that they have time to gather their things together and go to the toilet before departure. Unfortunately, the coach will be unable to wait for any late arrivals. Children will need to wear their school uniform and comfortable footwear.
