Dear Parents and Carers,

Y6 Residential Trip - 29th November to 1st December 2022

We are very excited to let you know details of the Year 6 residential for the next academic year, which will take place from Tuesday 29th November to Thursday 1st December 2022.

This year, we are thrilled to be able to offer the children a trip to **London** to explore the sights that our capital city has to offer. In terms 3 and 4, children will be learning about WW2 and this trip will offer an excellent opportunity to excite and engage them about this topic.

The table below outlines the itinerary for the three day visit and will give you details about the exciting places that the children will be visiting and the activities that they will be taking part in.

Tuesday 29th November:	
8am	Depart School for London (by coach)
12pm	Visit 'The Imperial War Museum'
3pm	Visit 'ZSL London Zoo'
6.30pm	Restaurant Meal
8.30pm	Check in to Accommodation (Youth Hostel Association Accommodation)

Wednesday 30 th November:	
8.30am	Breakfast at Accommodation
10.30am	Visit 'The National History Museum'
2pm	Visit 'The Tower of London'
5pm	Restaurant Meal
7.30pm	Visit a Theatre to experience a 'West End Show'





Friday 1 st December:	
8.30am	Breakfast at Accommodation
10am	Central London Sightseeing
2pm	Visit 'HMS Belfast'
5pm	Depart London for home (by coach)

The total cost of the visit per child will be **approximately £256.70** (including travel, meals, accommodation and admission to all of the attractions outlined above). This price is based on 55 children choosing to attend the residential but could vary very slightly if numbers signing up to attend the trip are higher or lower than expected. We also plan to involve the Y6 in various fundraising events throughout the year to try and help lower the cost. If you are experiencing difficulties in meeting all or part of the cost of this trip, please come and speak to us and we will do our best to help.

The trip is being booked through Diverse School Travel, a leading educational travel company for schools who will work closely with us during the whole tour planning process to ensure that your child will get the very best experience whilst away.

If you would like your child to participate in this exciting opportunity, please give permission via ParentPay **by paying a £25.00 non-refundable deposit by Friday 15th July 2022,** which will reserve your child a place on the trip.

Parents will be given the choice to pay the full cost of the trip up front, or, if you would prefer, to pay via instalments. All payments will be required to be made via ParentPay and the trip must be paid for in full prior to the visit. As with all trips, we have to ensure that we have sufficient parental voluntary contributions to cover our expenses, otherwise it may be necessary to cancel the whole trip.
