Dear Parent and Carers,

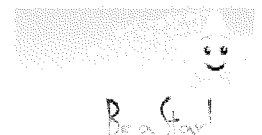


Guard of Honour
