Key Vocabulary

human feature(s)	Things in the environment that have been built by humans such as buildings, roads and bridges.
physical feature(s)	Things in the environment that are naturally there e.g. river, mountain, seas.
ocean	A large expanse of sea.
continent	A large expanse of land.
aerial photograph	A 'birds eye' view – an image taken from above.
plan perspective	A simple map of an area using symbols to represent human and physical features.
environment	The surroundings where a person, animal or plant lives.
atlas	A book of maps.
map symbol	Symbols show important landmarks, places and areas. They are used because maps are too small to contain lots of writing.

Interesting Facts

- ⇒ There are seven continents and five oceans on our planet.
- ⇒ The seven continents on our planet are: Africa, Asia, Antarctica, Europa, North America and South America and Oceania/Australia.
- ⇒ Asia is the largest continent in size. It has the biggest land area and the world's biggest population. This means most people on our Earth live on the Asian continent.
- ⇒ The five oceans of the world are called the Pacific, Atlantic, Southern, Arctic and Indian Oceans.
- ⇒ Oceans are large bodies of water that separate the seven continents of the world.
- ⇒ Long Sutton is a market town in Lincolnshire.
