As a school, we always want to enthuse learning and give children as many opportunities as we can to experience the wider world around them. We would therefore like to give the children in Year 2 the opportunity to go to Lincoln Castle to support their learning in term 3 after Christmas. Year 2 will be learning about life in castles and previous years have really enjoyed the experience and gained a lot from it. The children will be given a guided tour around the walls of the castle, learn to be an archer and take part in a medieval feast.

The total cost of the experience is £18.40 per child and we are asking for a voluntary contribution to meet the costs. We do understand that you may be unable to contribute at this time; we also recognise that you may wish to contribute an amount lower than the cost; please indicate whatever contribution you can afford on the forms link below.
