<u>Uniform Letter</u>

20th June 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

The summer holidays are fast approaching, and we hope that everyone will be able to have a lovely break and some time to relax and be with family. This is also the time of year when lots of families will be sorting uniform and purchasing new items as the children keep growing! To enable us to demonstrate our school values and to ensure that the children are smart and ready for school we would like your support in ensuring that children adhere to the following uniform policy.

From September the following expectations will be in place:

- Black or dark grey skirt/pinafore
- Black or dark grey trousers, long or short (not leggings)
- A Long Sutton school sweatshirt or plain navy jumper or navy cardigan
- White shirts, polo shirts or blouses
- Blue gingham dresses for the summer
- Sensible black school shoes or boots (no heels, trainers or fashion boots)
- Shoulder length to long hair should be tied up using a bobble and plain black or navy hair clips (no colourful hair bands, scrunchies or other hair accessories)
- Haircuts should be appropriate for school (no dyed hair and no shaved designs)
- One simple, flat pair of studs can be worn (no hooped earrings)
- A watch can be worn
- The only necklace that can be worn is in line with religious observance
- Nails should be short with no nail varnish
- No make up to be worn

PE Uniform

- Plain navy or black: shorts, skorts, tracksuit bottoms or leggings with no logos
- Plain navy or black sweatshirt with no logos or Long Sutton school sweatshirt (no hoodies)
- Plain white t-shirt or one with the school logo but no other logo (not a polo shirt)





• Black or white trainers

Children will be asked to change into their PE kit at school when they have a PE lesson. As the planned PE lesson can change days with little notice children should have their PE kit with them in school every day please. PE kits will be able to be stored in class lockers or on pegs.

All items of clothing should be clearly named.

Sweatshirts, polo shirts and T shirts with the school logo may all be purchased from our uniform supplier. If you do not wish to purchase a logoed item a plain version from a general supplier is acceptable.

If your child attends school in incorrect uniform, then the class teacher will send home a slip to you regarding the incorrect item(s).
