## Viking Visitor for Year 5 – Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022

We have planned to start Term 2 with a historical learning day led by a fantastic educational visitor for our Year 5 pupils. This workshop will be an interactive day of learning that is highly engaging with hands-on activities. In lessons, we will have started to explore the struggle for control of the Kingdom of England between the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings. The workshop explores the attack on Lindisfarne; who the Vikings were; where they were from; and why they were raiding. After looking at what a Viking raider is, they will train as a Viking warrior. The afternoon's activities include tales of Eric the Red; learning about farming, crafting, trading, and Dane law; religion and runes; and Kubb and other Viking pastimes.

We are inviting pupils to dress up in Viking style outfits, if they wish. There is **no expectation** to purchase an outfit; it could be as simple as wearing a long adult's shirt/T-shirt with a belt/rope at the waist, along with long socks to tuck a pair of trousers into.

We are asking for a **voluntary contribution of £8.00** towards the cost of the visit. If there are insufficient voluntary contributions, then the visit may not be able to go ahead.
