Y6 Residential Trip Tuesday 29th November to Thursday 1st December 2022

We are very excited to update you on our Year 6 residential trip to London from Tuesday 29th November to Thursday 1st December.

Payment

As you are aware, the total cost of the visit per child is **£246.70** (including travel, meals, accommodation, and admission to all of the attractions outlined below). All payment should now be **complete** via ParentPay. If your payment is not complete and you are experiencing difficulties in meeting all or part of the cost of this trip, please speak to the school office and we will do our best to help.

<u>Itinerary</u>

The trip itinerary has slightly changed as well as **our departure time**, but we will still be visiting all of the attractions originally planned. The confirmed itinerary for our trip is detailed below.

Medical

Thank you for completing the medical form for your child. If your child's medical conditions change, please let us know as soon as possible so we can ensure we have the correct information for the trip.

Money

We recommend no more than £10 spending money per day but there is no obligation to send any. Money will not be spent on food; it is purely for souvenirs at the attractions. Please put your child's money into three separate envelopes with your child's name on for each day.

Medical and Money Drop Off – 28.11.2022

Miss Jaques and Miss Hannam will be available in the school office to collect any medicine/inhalers and **spending money** for the trip to save time on the morning of departure. This drop off session will be from **3.30**-**4.30pm on Monday 28th November.** Medicine and inhalers that your child will need on the Monday night will need bringing in on the Tuesday morning (29th).

Snacks/Sweets

We ask that children only take one small pack of sweets on the trip to eat on the bus. A small pack of fruit pastilles, mentos, rolos or similar would be acceptable. The children should not have any food in their room at the hotel at all. We will be taking a range of fruit and biscuits with us that will be available at points during the day when we are together.







Return Journey Arrangements

On our return journey, we will be having a rest stop at a service station on route. This is where we will be preordering a McDonald's Happy Meal. The cost of this is £2.99 and will be available to pay on ParentPay prior to the visit. We will be sending home a meal selection form for your child to select their happy meal option.

Please note that in addition to the McDonald's Happy Meal, we will be providing fruit and biscuits for the children.

A few other reminders discussed at the parents meeting

- We will update you with any information via the school's Twitter and Facebook pages while we are away. Please keep an eye out on this for any changes to the expected arrival time home on the Thursday.
- Children are ambassadors for the school and are expected to **show exemplary behaviour** at all times. If a child's behaviour causes concern, parents will be contacted and expected to make arrangements for the child to be collected.
- Children are **not** allowed to bring any electronic devices with them on the trip e.g., no phones, iPads, music devices, hair straighteners etc.
