REMINDER: Bikeability Sessions for Year 5

If you are receiving this letter, you have already given permission for your child to attend the free Bikeability sessions which are being held Mon 23rd March through to Thursday 26th March. Children will be organised into small groups and will receive 2 hours training per day.

Bikeability is the government's national cycle training programme. The scheme aims to inspire more children to cycle by equipping them with the skills and confidence to ride more. Sessions begin with fun, progressive challenges/games which allow children to demonstrate skills, in order to progress to Level 2 which involves riding on local residential roads.

As described in the original letter, your child will need:

A roadworthy cycle without stabilisers

A helmet

Suitable clothing for cycling and the weather conditions

Please find a copy of the Cycle and Helmet Checklist attached (in case you have misplaced your previous copy) to ensure your child's cycle is safe and ready to use.

We are aware that there may be difficulty transporting bicycles back and forth to school each day, therefore, children will be able to leave their bicycles and helmets in classrooms overnight. On arrival at school each morning, children will be required to put their bicycle in the bike shed.
