Year 2 Trip to Lincoln Castle



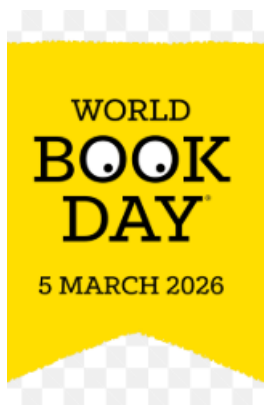

Parents Evenings

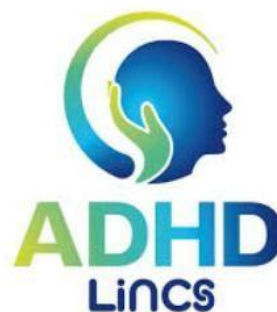
