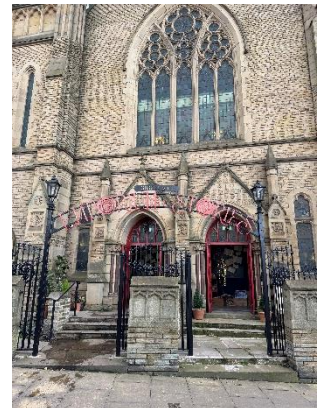
### **Pancakes**

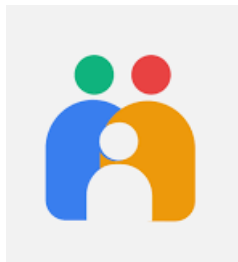
### **World Book Day**
