#### Whole class music tuition

Our Year 4 classes have now had their first two whole class music tuition sessions with the Lincolnshire Music Service. Everyone in Year 4 is now learning to play either a trumpet or a trombone which is very exciting! These sessions will continue throughout the autumn term up until Christmas. From January we plan on offering an after-school session called 'Mash Up Jam' to children in Year 4 where they will be able to continue learning their instrument for a small weekly fee (should there be enough interest in this.)



On Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October Key Stage Two children will be treated to a concert by the Boston Youth Jazz Orchestra. This is highly talented group of musicians and we are incredibly fortunate to be able to have them as visitors in our school. This will be a great opportunity for our children to see first hand what it can be like to play a brass instrument to a high standard.
