Fire Safety Year 2 and Year 6

Year 2 and Year 6 children enjoyed a visit from Lincolnshire Fire and Rescue this week. Year 2 learnt about what it's like to be a firefighter and how they get ready to go out to fight fires and help people. They also looked at things around the home such as kettles and ovens and why they should only ever use them with an adult. Finally, they talked about what to do if there ever was a fire and how to get help.

Year 6 learnt about all the different roles that fire-fighters have and how they help to prevent fires by educating people



on the dangers of faulty electrical equipment. They watched a video about how quickly a fire can spread and what to do if they discover a fire. They also saw what it takes for a fire to thrive and looked at the pyramid of heat, fuel and oxygen. Everyone then all had a go at 'stop, drop and roll'. Afterwards, Year 6 were given a leaflet on how to keep their homes safe and how to apply for free installation of fire alarms in our homes.
